SELECTION PROCESS

Preamble: The amount of bursary money available will be reviewed annually and will depend on available financial resources. The total amount allotted shall not exceed **\$1,500.00** in a fiscal year.

Applications for a bursary will be received by the Chairperson of the Bursary Committee.

- Applicants will be informed when their application has been received.
- Applications will be reviewed by the Bursary Committee.
- Recommendations for acceptance or rejection will be brought to the meeting of the Executive Committee.
- The Executive Committee will decide how bursary funds will be awarded. • Applicants will be informed of the Committee's decision as quickly as possible. • Successful applicants will be sent a cheque for the approved amount once proof of payment for the learning event has been received.
- Successful applicants may apply for the same bursary in subsequent years.
